



Artistic Expression

The Chapel invites noteworthy instrumentalists, soloists, choirs, and visual artists to share their talents, encouraging art from a wide spectrum of perspectives and generating conversations about faith.

\$2,500

offsets the costs to mount and promote a student art display

\$5,000

pays the first violin section for the annual performance of Handel's *Messiah*

Sacred Music

Through worship services, concerts, and recitals, Chapel Music pairs timeless selections with new compositions that mirror and amplify one another, signaling music as both worship of God and an expression of human longing for God.

\$100

covers the cost of tuning a Chapel piano

\$1,000

secures a brass quartet for one Sunday worship service

Vibrant Worship

Worship at Duke Chapel thoughtfully pairs liturgical tradition with ethnically and culturally diverse musical and aesthetic offerings, providing inspiring music and faithful preaching.

\$250

pays for Communion bread for one semester

\$500

offsets the printing cost of Sunday bulletins for one week

PathWays Student Ministry

PathWays offers students opportunities for study, artistic expression, counsel, service, and community, as purposeful steps toward bridging their distinctive gifts and talents with the world's deepest needs.

\$1,000

provides a grant for two Chapel Scholars to participate in a mission trip or service project

\$3,500

covers expenses for a Summer Intern to live in intentional Christian community and work with a local nonprofit for one month

Interfaith Engagement

Students deepen their own faith commitments by organizing and participating in service events, dialogue dinners, text studies, and public events that draw participation from their peers and from community members of many faith traditions.

\$1,000

provides funding for a student to plan and implement a campus interfaith program

\$3,000

covers the cost of an international interfaith trip for one student

Media Ministry

By enhancing its media capacity and equipment, the Chapel extends its mission and ministry through radio broadcasts, live telecasts, online streaming, and archiving of worship, music, and public dialogues, such as the Dean's Bridge Panels.

\$5,000

pays for the creation of a Chapel documentary or promotional video

\$10,000

pays for worship media systems upkeep for one year
